

# Diploma of Work Health and Safety



The BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety (WHS) is Australia's latest and leading diploma in occupational health and safety. This qualification reflects the role of individuals coordinating and maintaining the work health and safety (WHS) program in an organisation. The qualification applies to supervisors and managers who apply a substantial knowledge base and well-developed skills in a wide variety of WHS contexts.

## DISTANCE LEARNING

Distance learning students can choose their electives and timeframe in line with the qualification rules for completion of training. Timeframes will be negotiated with the trainer but the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) suggests that a student should complete this qualification between six months to two years. A My Qualification Plan (MQP) and Training Plan (TP) will be put in place to assist through the learning program.

## FLEXIBLE DELIVERY MODES

These include a variety of different methods of training such as face-to-face workshops, distance learning, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or mixed delivery. ## PATHWAYS

Students may enter into the BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety after successful completion of the five core units from the BSB41419 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Before commencement of this BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety students must demonstrate successful completion of the core units of competency from the BSB41419 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety or equivalent competencies. Equivalent competencies are **predecessors** to the following units which have been mapped as equivalent. Your training coordinator will assist with this entry requirement.

- BSBWHS412 Assist with workplace compliance with WHS laws
- BSBWHS413 Contribute to implementation and maintenance of WHS consultation and participation processes
- BSBWHS414 Contribute to WHS risk management
- BSBWHS415 Contribute to implementing WHS management systems
- BSBWHS416 Contribute to workplace incident response.
