## **Certificate II in Security Operations**



The security industry is one with diverse opportunities. By completing a CPP20218 Certificate II in Security Operations, you will open up many doors. This qualification reflects the role of a security officer, responsible for maintaining safety and security by patrolling, protecting or guarding property while unarmed, and screening entry, monitoring behaviour and removing persons from premises.

Any person wishing to gain employment within the Security Industry must hold a Security licence. To obtain this licence you must have first completed an approved training course. The CPP20128 Certificate II in Security Operations is the first course that you should complete. Alana Kaye's security course is developed with industry and is trained by experts who have years of experience in the security industry.

Courses are conducted approximately every two weeks in our Darwin and Gold Coast (Southport) locations.

#### DISTANCE LEARNING

Distance learning students can choose their electives and timeframe in line with the qualification rules for completion of training. Timeframes will be negotiated with the trainer but the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) suggests that a student should complete this qualification between six months to two years. A My Qualification Plan (MQP) and Training Plan (TP) will be put in place to assist through the learning program.

#### **FLEXIBLE DELIVERY MODES**

Alana Kaye provides a number of options for flexible delivery of qualifications. These include a variety of different methods of training such as face-to-face workshops, distance learning, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or mixed delivery. Selection of elective units can also be tailored to individual requirements following discussions with the Alana Kaye team and in line with the packaging rules.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for a licence, participants must:

- · Be 18 years or older
- · Undergo a criminal history check
- · Pass the required training course.

It is a requirement for this course that students must have good verbal and written English skills. Students will be assessed for language, literacy, and numeracy ability upon enrolment.

A criminal history check is one of the requirements when applying for a Security Licence. It is the responsibility of each participant to check their eligibility prior to booking into this
