

# Certificate II in Security Operations



The security industry is one with diverse opportunities. By completing a Certificate II in Security Operations, you will open up many doors. This qualification reflects the role of a security officer, responsible for maintaining safety and security by patrolling, protecting or guarding property while unarmed, and screening entry, monitoring behaviour and removing persons from premises.

Any person wishing to gain employment within the Security Industry must hold a Security licence. To obtain this licence you must have first completed an approved training course. The Certificate II in Security Operations is the first course that you should complete. Alana Kaye's security course is developed with industry and is trained by experts who have years of experience in the security industry.

Courses are conducted approximately every two weeks in our Darwin and Gold Coast (Southport) locations.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for a licence, participants must:

- Be 18 years or older
- Undergo a criminal history check
- Pass the required training course.

It is a requirement for this course that students must have good verbal and written English skills. Students will be assessed for language, literacy, and numeracy ability upon enrolment.

A criminal history check is one of the requirements when applying for a Security Licence. It is the responsibility of each participant to check their eligibility prior to booking into this course.
